	Deut. 5:12-15	4 th Commandment, kept to remind us that God has saved us from slavery.
	Luke 4:16	Jesus went into the synagogue as was his custom and stood up to read.
	Isa. 58:13, 14	If you turn your foot from the Sabbath...promise if the Sabbath is kept, he will give us our inheritance
	Neh. 13. 15-21	All business should cease before Sundown. No buying or selling should take place.
	Matt. 12:10-13	We should save life on the Sabbath, get the animal out of the ditch
	Mark 2:27, 28	The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath. Jesus is Lord of the day.
	Ex. 16:28-30	The story of the Manna and not gathering on the Sabbath but preparing on Friday for Sabbath
	Gen. 2:1-3	God blessed the seventh day at creation (before there was a Jewish nation.)
	Acts 17:2	Paul kept the Sabbath
	Isaiah 66:22, 23	From one new moon to the next, the Sabbath will be kept in heaven.
	Ex. 31:12-18	God gives Moses the two tables of stone written on by the finger of God. Sabbath was to be a perpetual sign. No work and there is a penalty for work.
	Matt 24:20	Pray that your flight be not in winter nor on the Sabbath.
	Acts 13:14-44; 17:2, 18:4	Texts about the disciples keeping the Sabbath.
	Ezekiel 22:26	Many sins go with not keeping the Sabbath and God is profaned.
	Ex. 23:12	A repeat of the 4 th commandment.
	Ex 35:2, 3	No work on the Sabbath, not even kindling a fire.
	Mark 15:42	Friday is a preparation day
	Mark 16:1,2	Sabbath was over and on the first day of the week the women went to the tomb, so they kept Sabbath as did Jesus in the grave
	Luke 6:5	Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath
	Heb. 4:4-11	There remains a rest for the people of God, to cease from our works just like God rested from his work.



Jer. 17: 21-22	Probably a reference to not carrying cargo for business. See Neh. 13:15-21.
Luke 13:14-16	Jesus is in trouble for healing on the Sabbath, yet the leaders thought it was ok to help animals on the Sabbath, Luke 14:5
Eze. 20:12, 20	Sabbath was given as a sign of sanctification.
Rev. 1:10	Lord's day is the Sabbath day. See Matthew 12:8
Matthew 12:8	Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath
Luke 23:54-56	Preparation day is the day before Sabbath. The spices for the body of Jesus weren't put on till Sunday, Luke 24:1.
Heb. 13:8	Jesus is the same yesterday, today, and forever.
Deut. 28:12-13	God will make you the head and not the tail if we obey his commandments.
Matt. 11:28-30	Come unto me and I will give you rest. (cross reference with Hebrews 4 about the Sabbath Rest.)
Matthew 15:9, Mark 7:7	In vain do they worship me teaching for doctrine the commandments of men.
Romans 3:20	By the law is the knowledge of the sin.
Genesis 1	Each day starts on the evening of the previous day (and the evening and the morning were the first day)
Nehemiah 13:19	The Sabbath is kept from evening to evening
Psalms 19:7	The Law of God is perfect converting the soul.

- Choose a color that makes sense to you given the topic.
- Choose colors you can differentiate one thing from another.
- Color in the whole verse so you can clearly see the color (as opposed to just underlining it)
- If one text is used twice, use the first color to underline it, second color to make a vertical line of that color on the left-hand side of the text.
- Extra spaces are so you can add in more verses
- Column to the left is for the purpose of checking off each verse as you color it in your Bible. This way, you can keep track of where you stopped for the day, until your Bible marking project is complete.

Another idea for Bible marking:

Read through the Bible and mark topics such as those below using a different color of pen for each topic.

1. Bible Doctrines all with one color (This is not as helpful as the above system especially if wanting to give a Bible study.)
2. Bible Promises
3. God's Character (what He is like)
4. What God expects of us or what we should do.
5. Interesting things you want to remember.
